We are aiming to be the absolute BEST within our league...to set the benchmark...in the area of Conduct and Behaviour and the following guidelines are aimed at achieving just that. This standard has to be set and exemplified by the Leaders of our Club, which includes all Club Officials.

To achieve this standard, our officials agree to...

- Be proud to represent the Flagstaff Hill Football Club
- Respect the rights, dignity & worth of every person, regardless of their ability, gender, cultural background or religion
- Role model appropriate behaviour by demonstrating high standards of integrity, equity and fairness
- Encourage, support & reward innovation
- Make it clear that verbal & physical abuse is unacceptable and will result in disciplinary action
- Ensure appropriate rules & regulations are implemented that emphasise fair play & encourage enjoyment & sportsmanship
- Be responsible for the conduct of players, spectators and officials.
- Accept responsibility for the safety & welfare of players, umpires and officials above all else
- Ensure appropriate screening when recruiting coaches, trainers and support staff members
- Maintain confidentiality about sensitive information
- Complete consent for criminal history checks
- Abide by the FHFC's Child Protection Policy
- Be consistent, objective & courteous when making decisions
- Administer discipline in a just & fair but positive & supportive manner

Any breach of the above conduct agreement will be addressed by the President and/or Chairman of the Flagstaff Hill Football Club. Persistent concerns or breaches may result in disciplinary action.
